## RE: Recording Fee Increase Mandated by Senate Bill 780 For Certain Government Release of Lien, Encumbrances or Notices

On September 20, 2019, the California Legislature passed Senate Bill 780, which amended Government Code 27361.3, relating to the calculation of recording fees for all releases of lien, encumbrances or notices executed by the state, any municipality, county, city, district, or other political subdivision.

On December 03, 2024, the Orange County Clerk-Recorder was authorized to adjust its recording fees to be effective January 1, 2025

Please be advised that in accordance with SB 780 and Government Code 27361.3 (a), the Orange County Clerk-Recorder will amend its fee for recording every release of lien, encumbrance, or notice, executed by those referenced entities from \$10 to \$18, effective January 1, 2025.
